ASPIRA MUSIC WORKSHOPS SATURDAY 12 FEBRUARY

Jazz theory - 12.45pm

Understand jazz harmony and walk away with all of the fundamentals needed to analyse and understand the most complex of jazz harmony. This workshop will be run by Spencer Wilson and is suitable for intermediate students.

Songwriting - 12.45pm

Ever wanted to write your own song? This workshop will give you the basics of songwriting so you can get started on your own. We will look at simple ways to write lyrics, chord progressions and melodies. Run by Daniel Philippe and suitable for all ages.

Improvisation - 2pm

Spencer Wilson, our guitar teacher, is offering this workshop in improvisation. Learn how to improvise in a way that is interesting and authentic for you, the band you're with, and the audience. With a focus on rhythms, active listening, and specific examples of melodic lines, everyone is sure to walk away with something new. Open to all ages and all instruments.

Body Minded - 2pm

Learn how to use your body in a holistic way to more effectively support your performance. This workshop is for everyone regardless of age or instrument. If you'd like to gain more knowledge in how your body moves and how the different parts work together, so you can be a better musician, then this workshop is for you. This will be run by Daniel Philippe who is an accredited BodyMinded teacher.

Group class for young beginners - 3.15pm

This workshop is aimed at beginner students, 4-6 years of age, who would like to try out keyboard lessons in a group setting. Students will play music games and learn some simple songs on the keyboard. It will be run by Nattagan Pettong, one of our experienced piano teachers.

Introduction to Indian singing - 3.15pm

We are very pleased to offer this workshop in Indian singing, run by experienced teacher and performer, Rahim Zullah. This is aimed at beginners and covers some of the basic techniques of Indian classical singing. People of all ages and cultures are welcome.

Singing skills through music theatre - 4.30pm

Improve your singing through your favourite songs from musical theatre. This workshop will cover singing skills and techniques using songs from musical theatre. It will be run by our singing teacher, Rose Boylan-Ascione, who has many years experience teaching and singing musical theatre.

Indian music appreciation - 4.30pm
